Priorities of the German Presidency 2011-2012

1. Contribute to low-carbon, secure and affordable energy systems of the Baltic Sea Countries.
2. Enhance cooperation on the expansion of renewable energy sources, the increase of energy efficiency and the integration of energy infrastructure in the Baltic Sea Region.
3. Complete and follow-up on project activities of the BASREC budget framework 2009-2011 in order to fulfill these goals.
4. Hold a successful BASREC Ministerial Meeting in May 2012 in Berlin providing new perspectives for further cooperation.
5. Provide the basis for the Russian BASREC presidency 2012-2013.
