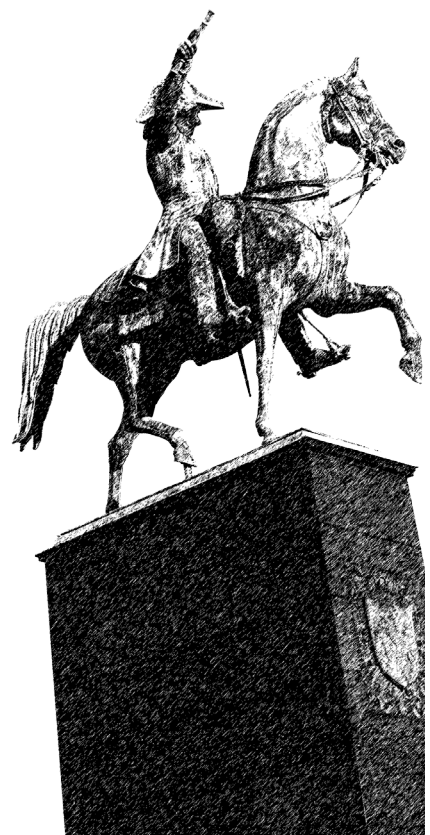
Foreign Correspondents from the CBSS Member and Observer States based in Stockholm
